

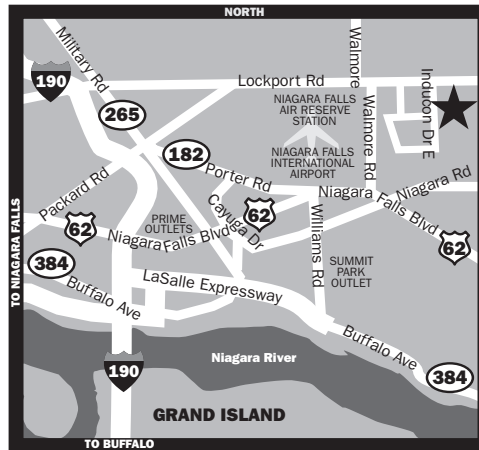
Horizon Village is a private residential treatment program serving the Western Region of New York State. The program is designed for individuals who are chemically dependent and who have been unable to establish and maintain abstinence through outpatient treatment. Horizon Village residents participate in a comprehensive, individualized recovery program.

- Van service from Horizon Health Service's 60 East Amherst Street location is available on Saturdays. The van departs the East Amherst Street location at noon and returns at 6:30 p.m.
- Packages brought to Horizon Village for residents are marked and held in the Reception Area and are normally distributed to residents after visiting hours.
- Items such as purses, bags, pagers, cell phones, etc., are not permitted in resident areas.
- Residential wings (dormitories) are always off limits to visitors. Children under 12, however, may visit these wings under the supervision of a staff member.
- Visitors are expected to dress and behave appropriately while at Horizon Village. Anyone appearing to be "under the influence" will be immediately asked to leave, and may lose visiting privileges.
- To assure and respect the privacy of our residents, all visitors are approved by the resident and the primary counselor. A consent-release form must be signed prior to any visitation.
- From time to time, Horizon Village sponsors special events planned with the entire family in mind, especially children. Special mailings will be sent with details of upcoming events as they occur.

**Visitors arriving after 1:30 p.m. will not be eligible to visit unless permission was granted in advance.

Family Counseling Sessions are also available after visiting hours or at times during the week. Please call to arrange an appointment.

Under certain circumstances, special arrangements may be made to visit at times other than Wednesdays or Saturdays. Please make requests for special visits through our Family Program Counselor.

- Horizon Village is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is allowed only on the outdoor patio.
- Residents are not allowed to have their own radios, stereos, cassette or CD players. There are stereos in the resident lounges for community use.
- Residents may use the telephone after completion of their first two weeks of the program. Non-emergency contact with family or friends is not permitted during the first two weeks.
- Upon admission, residents identify those individuals whom they want to participate in the Family Program. At the time of the Family Program, visitation is scheduled. Other visits may be arranged with the resident's primary counselor.
- During the initial stages of treatment, residents may leave the facility only when accompanied by staff. At later stages of the program, residents are permitted to leave on pass with a family member or selected individual.
- Horizon Village believes that family and friends are very important to an individual's recovery.
